

CARAVAN RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

In order for every student, volunteer and staff to have a great experience on this trip, the Caravan team expects everyone to...

- Respect each other. Respect the staff and property at all locations of the trip. Be respectful of others in the community spaces and in public. Do your best to care for those around you; be “includers” not excluders! Offer to help if you see a student or staff member needing help with set-up, clean up, etc.
- Sessions, small groups and other assigned large group activities are mandatory. You won’t want to miss out on any of these!
- No girls in boys’ rooms and no boys in girls’ rooms.
- Dress code will be followed at all times. (See following).
 - Girls must have a modest one piece swimsuit or tankini; students will be asked to wear shorts and T-shirts if suits are not appropriate.
 - Boys must wear board shorts (no speedos); **Shirts** must be worn when not at the pool, lake, or other water activities.
 - When choosing what to pack, dress modestly. Staff reserves the right to ask you to change if clothes are not appropriate.
 - No clothing with crude, violent, or sexually explicit words or references.
- No one is allowed to leave the Caravan group and its activities without prior permission from a parent or guardian and permission from a Caravan core staff member. Do not go anywhere alone; always have a buddy/group and let a leader know where you are.
- Always be aware—if your bus buddy is missing, roommate is missing, small group member is missing...let us know ASAP!
- Regardless of your age, you may not be pierced or tattooed while on Caravan.
- The use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco will not be tolerated. The Caravan staff reserves the right to send violators home at their own expense.
- I understand that I may be given a name tag, lanyard, and/or wrist band and am expected to wear it at all times as a form of identification for the event.
- Be careful with your property! You are responsible for what you bring!
- Be respectful. You are representing our group. Be appropriate, be thoughtful, clean up, and treat others kindly.
