Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

Icebreaker:

- 4. When you think about approaching the throne of God what images or scenes do you imagine? What feelings and thoughts well up in you? Where do you think these thoughts and feelings come from?
- 5. How does your view of approaching God compare with the Bible Verses above?
