Who can you invite to join you?

God's Word anchors us in Jesus & shapes the way we live. As a church, we want to **Engage the Bible** in ways that help us know Jesus, follow Him, and grow as His disciples. You don't need a formal group or leader! Follow the reading plan, then connect along the way through a text, coffee, a meal, or a simple conversation. These simple relationships can become places where discipleship takes root as we encourage one another to listen to God's Word, respond to Jesus, and live out what we're learning.

This is how we become a village - people who help one another follow Jesus in the ordinary places of life. Who are you bringing along?

As you connect, let these questions guide your conversations:

- What stands out to you in this passage?
- What does this passage show us about who Jesus is?
- What does this passage show us about people?
- What truth do I need to believe or remember?
- How might what we've read change the way we live?
- Where do I see the good news of the Gospel?
- How can we pray for one another?
