Conversation Guide

1. **Read John 17:20-26 together.**
2. John 17:20 - “My prayer is not for them (Jesus’ disciples) alone, but for those who will believe in me through their message.”
 - a. **When you think about Jesus including you in his prayer, what happens in your heart or mind?**
3. Jesus’ one desire is for us (everyone) to know how much God loves. Jesus’ disciples made (or attempted to make) Jesus’ love the most visible thing in their lives.
 - a. **How do you get behind this one desire of Jesus?**
 - b. **How does Jesus desire for people to know the love of God motivated your unique life?**
4. The early Christian Church was spurred on and kept alive by one belief. Jesus is different than anything or anyone the world has ever seen. They developed creeds and remembered to pray as Jesus taught to keep them **unified, one body**.
 - a. **Share about a time you experienced unity or oneness in faith.**
 - b. **Pray the Lord’s Prayer (above) with your group.**
 - i. **Share one thing you need more of from this prayer.**
 - ii. **Share one thing you have received from this prayer.**
