



John 14:1-3 “Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. My Father’s house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.

John 14:6-11 “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. **7** If you really know me, you will know^{1b} my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him.”

8 Philip said, “Lord, show us the Father and that will be enough for us.” **9**

Jesus answered: “Don’t you know me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, ‘Show us the Father’? **10** Don’t you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in me? The words I say to you I do not speak on my own authority. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work.

John 14: 16-17 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be^{1a} in you.

Conversation Guide

The Gospel of John Chapter 14 records a very personal interaction with Jesus’ closest friends, he has important things to say to them before he goes to the cross.

We also need these words from Jesus to find our way forward no matter what our current situation.

Which of the following is the most difficult to grasp?

How could leaning into one of these truths help you find the way forward?

- 1. Focus beyond today.** See John 14:1-3 above. This isn’t the end, this is the beginning. Hebrews 6: This kind of hope is an anchor for our soul.
- 2. Jesus is God.** [Watch Dave’s Video from Minute 8:00- 14:22.](#) Jesus declares who he is, See John 14:6-11 above.
- 3. Jesus announces help is on the way.** See John 14:16-17 above.
